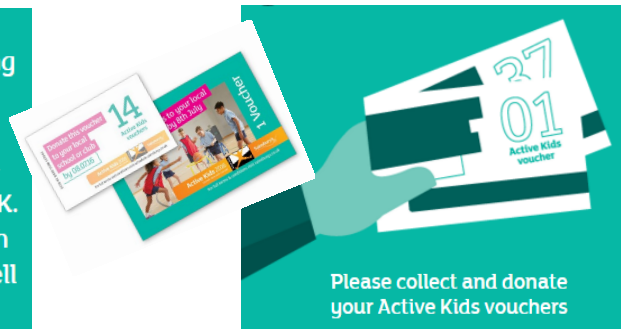

## School Uniform

All children must have full school uniform, worn correctly, for daily attendance at school. Parents and carers are asked to co-operate fully by providing the uniform and ensuring children wear it correctly to and from school, and at other times as required. Some items are only obtainable from the school's supplier, Kitbox. Please ensure that all articles of clothing and other items brought into school are clearly marked with the child's name.

**BOYS:** Charcoal grey trousers or shorts. White long or short sleeved shirt. Navy blue tie. Grey V-necked jumper with logo. Grey socks. Black shoes.

**GIRLS:** Charcoal grey skirt, pinafore dress or tailored trousers (flared or bootlegged styles are not acceptable). White long or short sleeved shirt. Navy blue tie. Grey V-necked cardigan with logo. Grey socks or tights. Black shoes. During the warmer months: As above or yellow checked summer dress. Grey or white socks.

Children must **not** wear polo shirts or blouses.



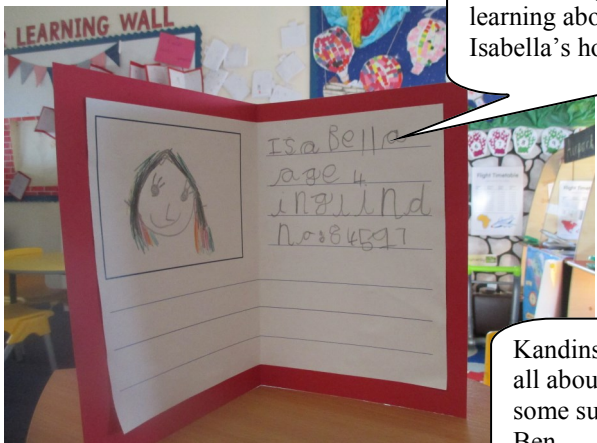
## Reminders and Information

- \* We would be very grateful for any old items of uniform that you may be willing to donate to the school, for us to use as spares, particularly skirts and trousers. We would also really appreciate donations of old/out grown socks, knickers & pants and plimsoles, that are still in good condition.
- \* Please make sure that your child has a full PE kit at school on their scheduled PE days.
- \* We would like to remind parents of the '48 hour' sickness bug rule. If your child has vomited you must keep them off school for 48 hours after the last bout of vomiting.
- \* The school takes part in the free school 'Cool Milk' scheme. Milk is available free of charge to all children up to the age of 5. Once your child has their 5th birthday milk is still available at a small cost. - \* Please do not park near the pedestrian bollards where Watmore Lane meets Woodward Close. The PCSO for Winnersh will be monitoring parking in and around Wheatfield School.
